



## Peer Discussion: Exit Ticket-For Students

### Instructions for Teachers:

In order to sum up the learning process of peer discussion, ask each student to write an exit ticket, explaining what he/she thought about the topic before the discussion and what he/she thinks now.

You can also ask students to share an example or to choose an opinion or information that was significant for them.

The tool is designed to allow students to reflect on the learning process and can also be used as an evaluation tool for the teacher.

Based on the thinking routine of "I Used to Think... Now I Think".
